EXCLUSION LISTS IDENTIFY THE MEDICATIONS THAT YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE WON'T COVER.

And while they protect profits for insurers and pharmacy benefit managers, **they can cause problems for patients:**



DELAYED ACCESS to critical treatment



REDUCED TREATMENT ADHERENCE



HIGHER OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS



INCREASED VISITS to the emergency room¹

Review your plan or pharmacy benefit manager's **exception policy.**




Ask your physician to help with submission.
