

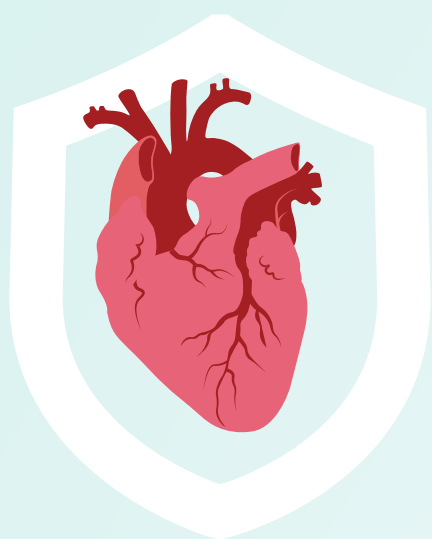

ALMOST 1/3



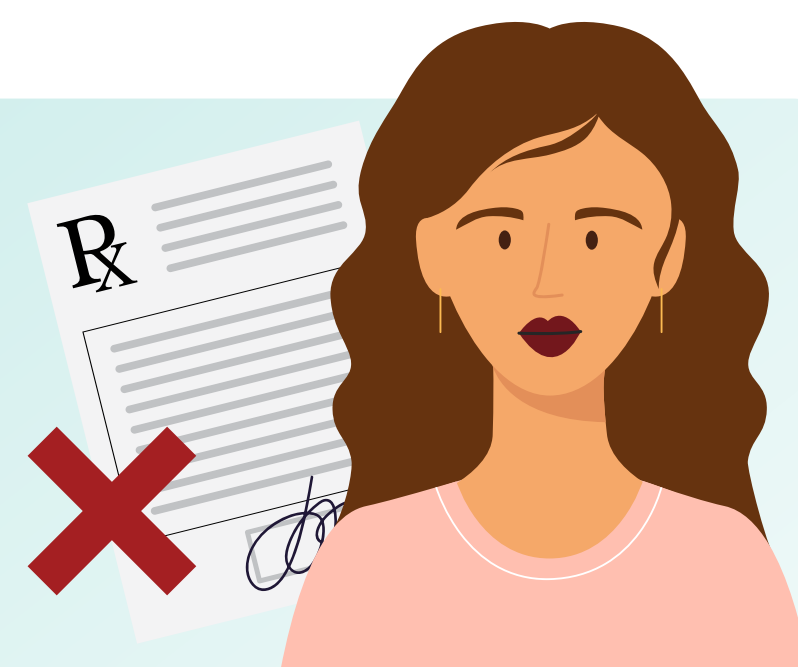
But insurers sometimes

than white patients.

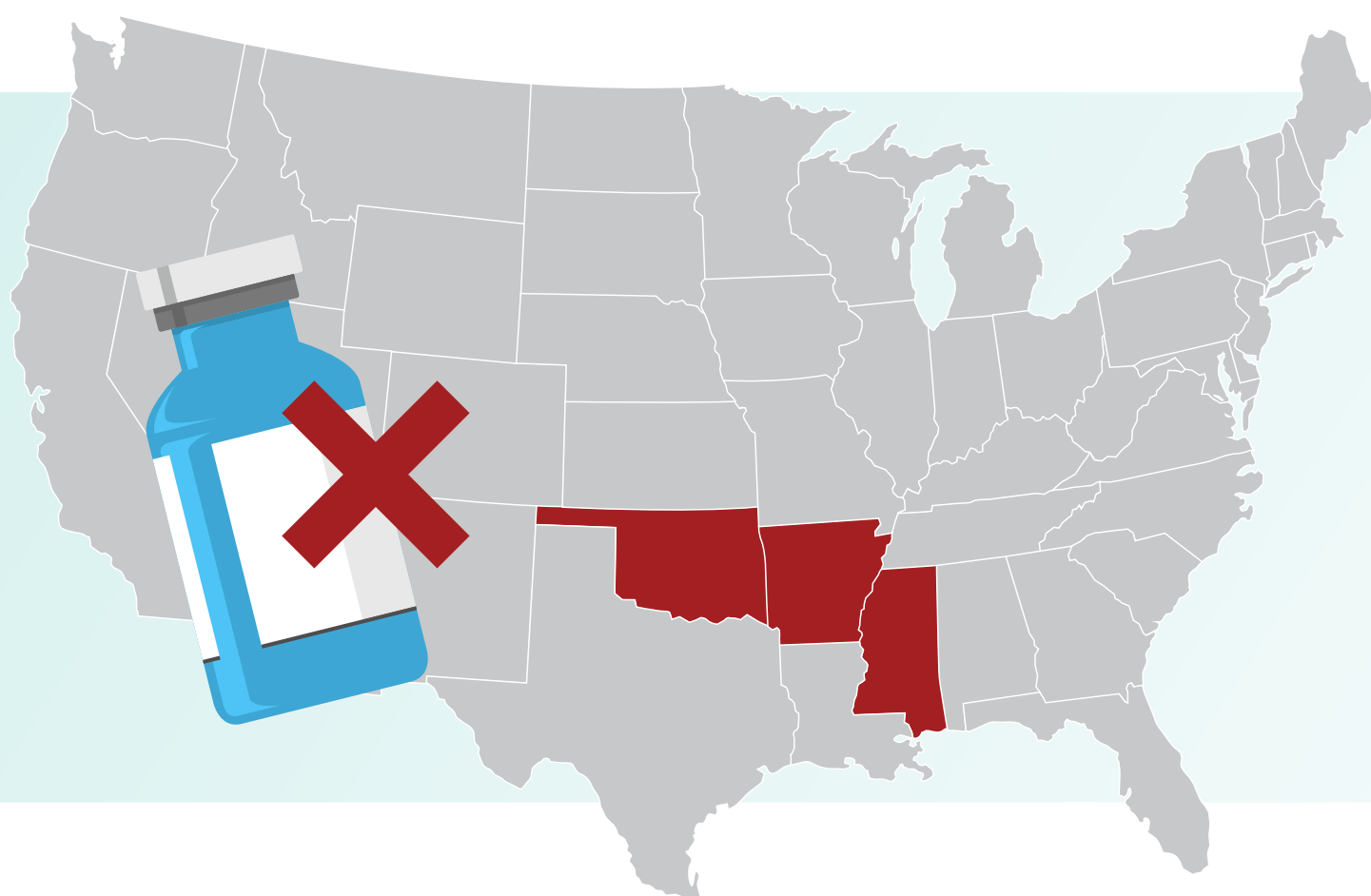


Hispanic patients have
